Aug 15-18 Before 12pm Fish, Fruits, Vegetables, Juice, Water
Absolute Fast 12:00pm-6:00pm
After 6pm Fish, Fruits, Vegetables, Juice, Water

Aug 19-21 The entire day
Liquids Only

Scripture Model:
Daniel chapter 10

DRINK PLENTY OF WATER

Your body can go a long time without food, but it can only go a few days without adequate liquids. Since you will not be getting the liquids normally contained in most foods, drink a lot of water while you fast. It helps you to flush the poisons out of your system. A fast is a good time to get free from cravings for sugar. Too many of us are addicted to sweets and drinking plenty of water will help you get over this craving. Putting a little lemon or lime in your water may help. When you go to the bathroom and your urine appears very yellow, don't worry, that shows that your body is flushing out the poisons from your system.

What is Fasting? Fasting means to humble ourselves before God, letting Him know we are willing to exchange physical comforts to seek Him. It is a call to seek God's face.

Results of Fasting. Fasting can result in a great movement of God in the call for healing, revival and spiritual awakening. Fasting accelerates your request.

Spiritual Suggestions

1. Determine/receive your desires as you delight yourself in the Lord and write them down. (Psalms 37:4)
2. Identify, confess, and repent of all revealed sin.
3. Keep a journal during your fast. Record revelations, manifested answers, blessings and miracles.
4. Pray and study the Word of God.
5. Watch less television; spend less time on the Internet and on the telephone.

Physical Suggestions

1. Expect some physical, mental and emotional discomfort as your body adjusts.
2. Take plenty vitamin C and drink lots of water.
3. Moderate consumption of natural fruit juice is suggested.

USE WISDOM WHEN YOUR FAST HAS ENDED

When your fast has ended and you begin to eat normal again, use wisdom. During the fast, don't save all the food you would have eaten and eat it later. After you finish the fast; don't eat limitlessly and destroy the spiritual health benefit derived from the fast.

Begin to eat slowly, not all at once and use this opportunity to develop better eating habits. Now that you have the flesh under control, this will be easier to do.

Daily Prayer and Scripture Schedule (KJV)

(8/01) CREATION of the universe, including plants, animals and humans **Genesis 1: 1-5, 31** *In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth.² And the earth was without form, and void; and darkness was upon the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God moved upon the face of the waters.³ And God said, Let there be light: and there was light.⁴ And God saw the light, that it was good: and God divided the light from the darkness.⁵ And God called the light Day, and the darkness he called Night. And the evening and the morning were the first day.³¹ And God saw every thing that he had made, and, behold, it was very good. And the evening and the morning were the sixth day.*

(8/02) RED SEA DIVIDED at just the right moment **Exodus 14:21-23, 26,28** *And Moses stretched out his hand over the sea; and the LORD caused the sea to go back by a strong east wind all that night, and made the sea dry land, and the waters were divided.²² And the children of Israel went into the midst of the sea upon the dry ground: and the waters were a wall unto them on their right hand, and on their left.²³ And the Egyptians pursued, and went in after them to the midst of the sea, even all Pharaoh's horses, his chariots, and his horsemen.²⁶ And the LORD said unto Moses, Stretch out thine hand over the sea, that the waters may come again upon the Egyptians, upon their chariots, and upon their horsemen.²⁸ And the waters returned, and covered the chariots, and the horsemen, and all the host of Pharaoh that came into the sea after them; there remained not so much as one of them.*

(8/03) MANNA sent daily to feed the Israelites **Exodus 16:14-15** *And when the dew that lay was gone up, behold, upon the face of the wilderness there lay a small round thing, as small as the hoar frost on the ground.¹⁵ And when the children of Israel saw it, they said one to another, It is manna: for they wist not what it was. And Moses said unto them, This is the bread which the LORD hath given you to eat.*

(8/04) WATER PROVIDED IN DESERT from the rock **Numbers 20:7-11** *And the LORD spake unto Moses, saying,⁸ Take the rod, and gather thou the assembly together, thou, and Aaron thy brother, and speak ye unto the rock before their eyes; and it shall give forth his water, and thou shalt bring forth to them water out of the rock: so thou shalt give the congregation and their beasts drink.⁹ And Moses took the rod from before the LORD, as he commanded him.¹⁰ And Moses and Aaron gathered the congregation together before the*

rock, and he said unto them, Hear now, ye rebels; must we fetch you water out of this rock?¹¹ And Moses lifted up his hand, and with his rod he smote the rock twice: and the water came out abundantly, and the congregation drank, and their beasts also.

(8/05) The WALLS OF JERICHO fall down at God's command **Joshua 6:6, 10, 20** *And Joshua the son of Nun called the priests, and said unto them, Take up the ark of the covenant, and let seven priests bear seven trumpets of rams' horns before the ark of the LORD.¹⁰ And Joshua had commanded the people, saying, Ye shall not shout, nor make any noise with your voice, neither shall any word proceed out of your mouth, until the day I bid you shout; then shall ye shout.²⁰ So the people shouted when the priests blew with the trumpets: and it came to pass, when the people heard the sound of the trumpet, and the people shouted with a great shout, that the wall fell down flat, so that the people went up into the city, every man straight before him, and they took the city.*

(8/06) The SUN AND MOON STAYED MOTIONLESS **Joshua 10:12-14** *Then spake Joshua to the LORD in the day when the LORD delivered up the Amorites before the children of Israel, and he said in the sight of Israel, Sun, stand thou still upon Gibeon; and thou, Moon, in the valley of Ajalon.¹³ And the sun stood still, and the moon stayed, until the people had avenged themselves upon their enemies. Is not this written in the book of Jasher? So the sun stood still in the midst of heaven, and hasted not to go down about a whole day.¹⁴ And there was no day like that before it or after it, that the LORD hearkened unto the voice of a man: for the LORD fought for Israel.*

(8/07) SAMSON'S STRENGTH **Judges 16: 28-30** *And Samson called unto the LORD, and said, O Lord God, remember me, I pray thee, and strengthen me, I pray thee, only this once, O God, that I may be at once avenged of the Philistines for my two eyes.²⁹ And Samson took hold of the two middle pillars upon which the house stood, and on which it was borne up, of the one with his right hand, and of the other with his left.³⁰ And Samson said, Let me die with the Philistines. And he bowed himself with all his might; and the house fell upon the lords, and upon all the people that were therein. So the dead which he slew at his death were more than they which he slew in his life.*

(8/08) WIDOW OF ZAREPHATH'S MEAL AND OIL — **1 Kings 17:14-16** *For thus saith the LORD God of Israel, The barrel of meal shall not waste, neither shall the cruse of oil fail, until the day that the LORD sendeth rain upon*

the earth.¹⁵ And she went and did according to the saying of Elijah: and she, and he, and her house, did eat many days.¹⁶ And the barrel of meal wasted not, neither did the cruse of oil fail, according to the word of the LORD, which he spake by Elijah.

(8/09) RESURRECTION—widow's son raised from dead **1 Kings 17:17, 21-22** And it came to pass after these things, that the son of the woman, the mistress of the house, fell sick; and his sickness was so sore, that there was no breath left in him.²¹ And he stretched himself upon the child three times, and cried unto the LORD, and said, O LORD my God, I pray thee, let this child's soul come into him again.²² And the LORD heard the voice of Elijah; and the soul of the child came into him again, and he revived.

(8/10) RESURRECTION—Elisha's bones revive the dead **2 Kings 13:21** And it came to pass, as they were burying a man, that, behold, they spied a band of men; and they cast the man into the sepulchre of Elisha: and when the man was let down, and touched the bones of Elisha, he revived, and stood up on his feet.

(8/11) PROTECTION IN BLAZING FIRE—Shadrach, Meshach, and Abed-nego delivered from a fiery furnace **Daniel 3:21-25** Then these men were bound in their coats, their hosen, and their hats, and their other garments, and were cast into the midst of the burning fiery furnace.²² Therefore because the king's commandment was urgent, and the furnace exceeding hot, the flames of the fire slew those men that took up Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego.²³ And these three men, Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, fell down bound into the midst of the burning fiery furnace.²⁴ Then Nebuchadnezzar the king was astonished, and rose up in haste, and spake, and said unto his counsellors, Did not we cast three men bound into the midst of the fire? They answered and said unto the king, True, O king.²⁵ He answered and said, Lo, I see four men loose, walking in the midst of the fire, and they have no hurt; and the form of the fourth is like the Son of God.

(8/12) PROTECTION FROM HUNGRY LIONS—Daniel saved from hungry lions in a sealed den **Daniel 6: 16-17, 19-22** Then the king commanded, and they brought Daniel, and cast him into the den of lions. Now the king spake and said unto Daniel, Thy God whom thou servest continually, he will deliver thee.¹⁷ And a stone was brought, and laid upon the mouth of the den; and the king sealed it with his own signet, and with the signet of his lords; that the purpose might not be changed concerning Daniel.¹⁹ Then the king arose very early in

the morning, and went in haste unto the den of lions.²⁰ And when he came to the den, he cried with a lamentable voice unto Daniel: and the king spake and said to Daniel, O Daniel, servant of the living God, is thy God, whom thou servest continually, able to deliver thee from the lions?²¹ Then said Daniel unto the king, O king, live for ever.²² My God hath sent his angel, and hath shut the lions' mouths, that they have not hurt me: forasmuch as before him innocency was found in me; and also before thee, O king, have I done no hurt.

(8/13) JONAH SURVIVED IN THE FISH'S BELLY and safely landed **Jonah 2:1-3, 7-10** Then Jonah prayed unto the LORD his God out of the fish's belly,² And said, I cried by reason of mine affliction unto the LORD, and he heard me; out of the belly of hell cried I, and thou heardest my voice.³ For thou hadst cast me into the deep, in the midst of the seas; and the floods compassed me about: all thy billows and thy waves passed over me.⁷ When my soul fainted within me I remembered the LORD: and my prayer came in unto thee, into thine holy temple.⁸ They that observe lying vanities forsake their own mercy.⁹ But I will sacrifice unto thee with the voice of thanksgiving; I will pay that that I have vowed. Salvation is of the LORD.¹⁰ And the LORD spake unto the fish, and it vomited out Jonah upon the dry land.

(8/14) MIRACULOUS CONCEPTION—the incarnation of Jesus by the Holy Ghost to a virgin. **Luke 1:35** And the angel answered and said unto her, The Holy Ghost shall come upon thee, and the power of the Highest shall overshadow thee: therefore also that holy thing which shall be born of thee shall be called the Son of God.

(8/15) MONEY—needed tax/tribute money provided in a randomly caught fish's mouth. **Matthew 17:24-27** And when they were come to Capernaum, they that received tribute money came to Peter, and said, Doth not your master pay tribute?²⁵ He saith, Yes. And when he was come into the house, Jesus prevented him, saying, What thinkest thou, Simon? of whom do the kings of the earth take custom or tribute? of their own children, or of strangers?²⁶ Peter saith unto him, Of strangers. Jesus saith unto him, Then are the children free.

²⁷ Notwithstanding, lest we should offend them, go thou to the sea, and cast an hook, and take up the fish that first cometh up; and when thou hast opened his mouth, thou shalt find a piece of money: that take, and give unto them for me and thee.

(8/16) HEALING—ten lepers **Luke 17:11-19** And it came to pass, as he went to Jerusalem, that he passed through the midst of Samaria and Galilee.¹² And as he

entered into a certain village, there met him ten men that were lepers, which stood afar off:¹³ And they lifted up their voices, and said, Jesus, Master, have mercy on us.¹⁴ And when he saw them, he said unto them, Go shew yourselves unto the priests. And it came to pass, that, as they went, they were cleansed.¹⁵ And one of them, when he saw that he was healed, turned back, and with a loud voice glorified God,¹⁶ And fell down on his face at his feet, giving him thanks: and he was a Samaritan.¹⁷ And Jesus answering said, Were there not ten cleansed? but where are the nine?¹⁸ There are not found that returned to give glory to God, save this stranger.¹⁹ And he said unto him, Arise, go thy way: thy faith hath made thee whole.

(8/17) WATER TURNED TO WINE *John 2:1-3,7-11* And the third day there was a marriage in Cana of Galilee; and the mother of Jesus was there.² And both Jesus was called, and his disciples, to the marriage.³ And when they wanted wine, the mother of Jesus saith unto him, They have no wine.⁷ Jesus saith unto them, Fill the waterpots with water. And they filled them up to the brim.⁸ And he saith unto them, Draw out now, and bear unto the governor of the feast. And they bare it.⁹ When the ruler of the feast had tasted the water that was made wine, and knew not whence it was: (but the servants which drew the water knew;) the governor of the feast called the bridegroom,¹⁰ And saith unto him, Every man at the beginning doth set forth good wine; and when men have well drunk, then that which is worse: but thou hast kept the good wine until now.¹¹ This beginning of miracles did Jesus in Cana of Galilee, and manifested forth his glory; and his disciples believed on him.

(8/18) LOAVES AND FISHES—4,000 fed from 7 loaves and a few little fishes *Matthew 15:32-38* Then Jesus called his disciples unto him, and said, I have compassion on the multitude, because they continue with me now three days, and have nothing to eat: and I will not send them away fasting, lest they faint in the way.³³ And his disciples say unto him, Whence should we have so much bread in the wilderness, as to fill so great a multitude?³⁴ And Jesus saith unto them, How many loaves have ye? And they said, Seven, and a few little fishes.³⁵ And he commanded the multitude to sit down on the ground.³⁶ And he took the seven loaves and the fishes, and gave thanks, and brake them, and gave to his disciples, and the disciples to the multitude.³⁷ And they did all eat, and were filled: and they took up of the broken meat that was left seven baskets full.³⁸ And they that did eat were four thousand men, beside women and children.

(8/19) HEALING—Centurion's servant healed *Luke 7:6-10*. Then Jesus went with them. And when he was now not far from the house, the centurion sent friends to him, saying unto him, Lord, trouble not thyself: for I am not worthy that thou shouldst enter under my roof.⁷ Wherefore neither thought I myself worthy to come unto thee: but say in a word, and my servant shall be healed.⁸ For I also am a man set under authority, having under me soldiers, and I say unto one, Go, and he goeth; and to another, Come, and he cometh; and to my servant, Do this, and he doeth it.⁹ When Jesus heard these things, he marvelled at him, and turned him about, and said unto the people that followed him, I say unto you, I have not found so great faith, no, not in Israel.¹⁰ And they that were sent, returning to the house, found the servant whole that had been sick.

(8/20) HEALING—woman's issue of blood healed *Mark 5:25-29* And a certain woman, which had an issue of blood twelve years,²⁶ And had suffered many things of many physicians, and had spent all that she had, and was nothing bettered, but rather grew worse,²⁷ When she had heard of Jesus, came in the press behind, and touched his garment.²⁸ For she said, If I may touch but his clothes, I shall be whole.²⁹ And straightway the fountain of her blood was dried up; and she felt in her body that she was healed of that plague.

(8/21) RESURRECTION of Jesus Christ after declared dead and buried for days *John 21:1-2,5-7,10-14* After these things Jesus shewed himself again to the disciples at the sea of Tiberias; and on this wise shewed he himself. ² There were together Simon Peter, and Thomas called Didymus, and Nathanael of Cana in Galilee, and the sons of Zebedee, and two other of his disciples. ⁵ Then Jesus saith unto them, Children, have ye any meat? They answered him, No.⁶ And he said unto them, Cast the net on the right side of the ship, and ye shall find. They cast therefore, and now they were not able to draw it for the multitude of fishes.⁷ Therefore that disciple whom Jesus loved saith unto Peter, It is the Lord. Now when Simon Peter heard that it was the Lord, he girt his fisher's coat unto him, (for he was naked,) and did cast himself into the sea. ¹⁰ Jesus saith unto them, Bring of the fish which ye have now caught. ¹² Jesus saith unto them, Come and dine. And none of the disciples durst ask him, Who art thou? knowing that it was the Lord.¹³ Jesus then cometh, and taketh bread, and giveth them, and fish likewise.¹⁴ This is now the third time that Jesus shewed himself to his disciples, after that he was risen from the dead.
